



















OBERFIELD BRICK INSTRUCTION SHEET

The following are recommendations for installing and cleaning Oberfield's Limestone Brick:

INSTALLATION:

- When pulling brick off the cubes, pull down from multiple cubes for maximum color blending.
- On a modular brick, the outside cores are off-set towards architectural face.
- On a utility brick, the outside cores are off-set towards architectural face.

CONTROL JOINTS:

Oberfield's recommends that control joints be designed into the project to minimize potential shrinkage. Concrete masonry veneer units, like all concrete products, tend to decrease in volume as drying occurs. Shrinkage cracks in concrete masonry are an aesthetic, rather than structural concern. Whenever possible, control joints should be located where stress concentrations occur. On residential construction, Oberfield's recommends horizontal joint reinforcement be placed at 16 in. o.c..

This will help compensate for not placing control joints at every window opening. Most control joints on residential construction can be hid behind downspouts or placed adjacent to the edge of quoins. Another option is to stagger the control joint to follow the mortar joint.

CLEANING CONCRETE MASONRY:

New Construction

In order to reduce the amount of cleaning required at the completion of a building, walls should be cleaned each day.

Mortar droppings should be allowed to harden slightly, then scraped off with a trowel or wood scraper. A small piece of broken block is also effective, followed by brushing with a stiff bristle or stainless steel wire brush (never use a steel wire brush).

Good masonry practices will minimize the amount of final cleaning significantly. Turning scaffolding boards at the end of the day and using sand or straw at the base of the wall will eliminate stains that are very difficult to remove later. Another important step is to cover the top of unfinished walls at the end of each day. This will prevent water from entering the cavities and will help prevent efflorescence. The plastic or tarps should drape at least two feet down each side of the wall.

Final cleaning will be easier if it occurs approximately one week after completion of walls (newly constructed walls must set 4 or 5 days to allow the mortar to harden prior to cleaning).

Never use high pressure cleaning! The use of high-pressure power washers will most certainly alter the appearance of a concrete masonry wall and could cause un-repairable damage to the building. A pressure washer with a maximum of 200 psi and a wide flare nozzle held 12 to 18 inches from the surface will give excellent results on most projects. Pre-wetting walls is a necessary first step. Work in sections from top down for best results.

CHEMICAL CLEANING:

If good masonry practices are followed, chemical cleaning will seldom be necessary. If required, call Oberfield's for suggested cleaning solutions.

- Follow mix solutions and directions of manufacturer. Always pre-wet surfaces prior to application of any cleaning solution.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

Mortar:

Using a lower compressive strength mortar, Type N, is often specified because it tends to be more flexible than other mortar types.






